Lucas sees a soccer ball on the playground that doesn't seem to belong to anyone. How can Lucas act correctly?

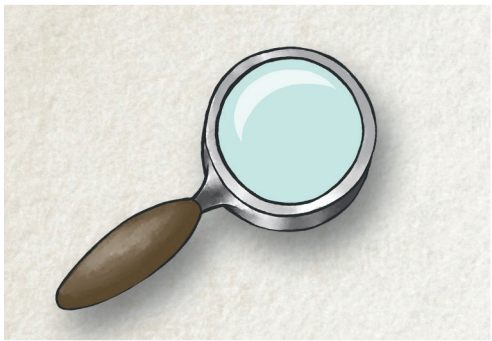
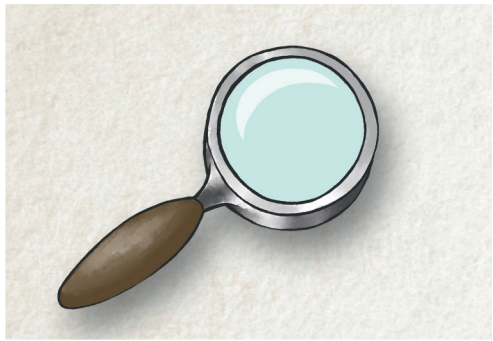
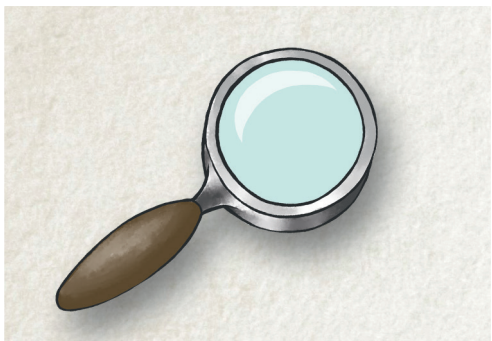
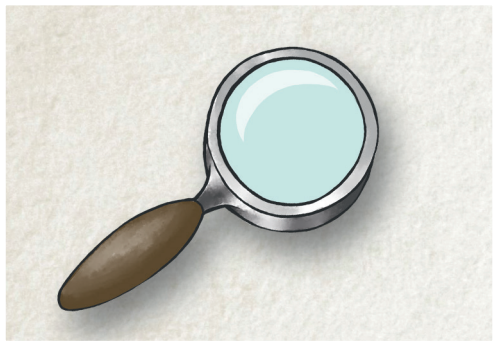
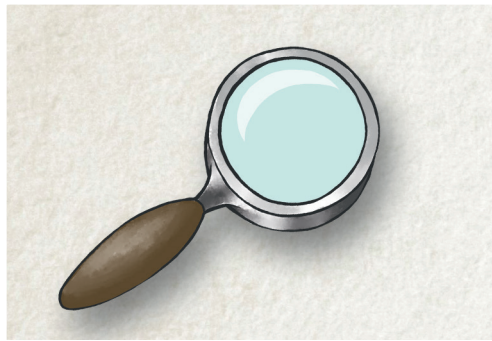
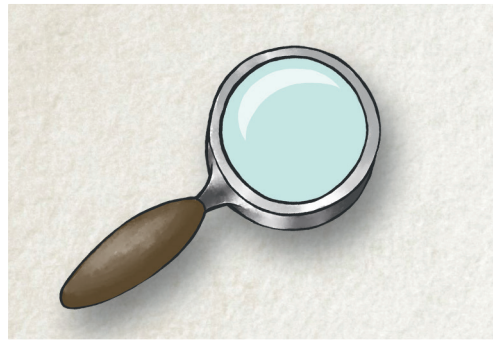
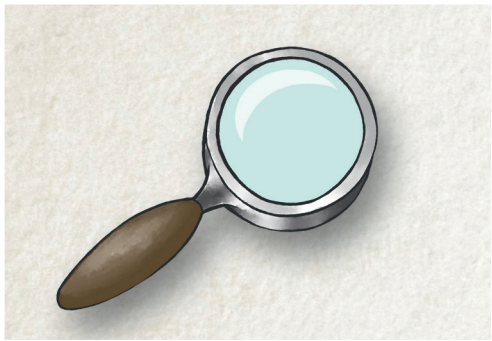
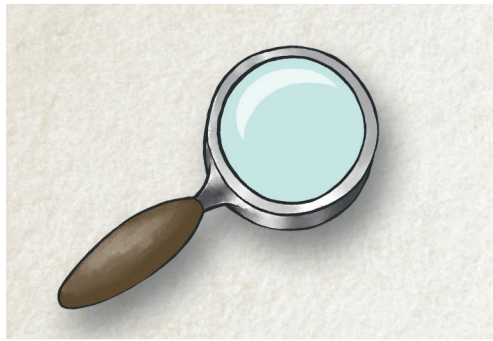
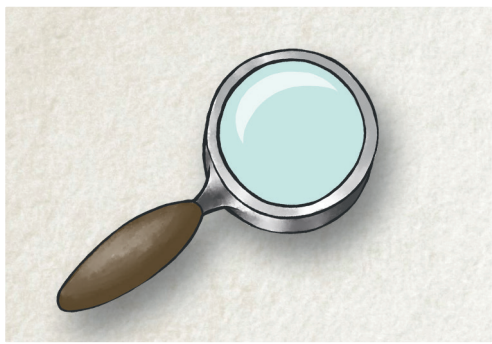
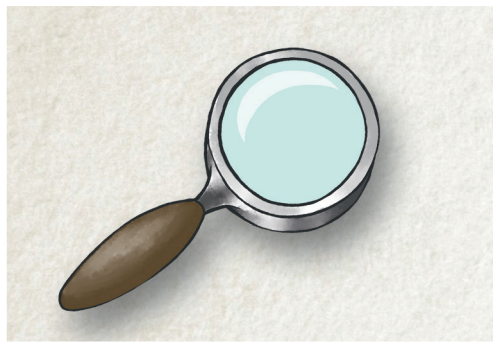
